The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region 7 has compiled the Administrative Record (AR) for the emergency response removal action at the Mercury-Louisiana Avenue Superfund Site in St. Louis, Missouri.

The AR is the official site file that contains the technical documents relied upon by EPA to determine that a response action at the site was necessary. EPA developed this document collection to form a clear understanding of the site.

EPA's on-site activities include removal of mercury and mercury-impacted materials, including wooden flooring from a residence in St. Louis and ventilating the building.
